"Unexpected Event" means any act, circumstance or event beyond the control of the Darwin Waterfront Corporation caused or arising from but not limited to acts of God, public enemies, government restraint, riots, strikes, lockouts, labour troubles, epidemic, civil disturbances, fire, lightning, storm, tidal waves, cyclones or other severe weather conditions, water contamination, theft, explosions, fault or neglect of independent contractors.

The Darwin Waterfront Corporation has the right to close the Wave Lagoon if the Darwin Waterfront Corporation considers that this is necessary as a result of some Unexpected Event. Wave Lagoon patrons will not be entitled to any compensation or a refund of the ticket price paid should this occur.
