

Terms & Conditions

General

- These terms and conditions together with any specific rules set out in Competition Notices (as defined below) are the Competition Rules. By entering the Competition, entrants agree to be bound by these Rules.
- Rules specific to this competition are displayed in a 'notice' on the competition page on www.waterfront.nt.gov.au. In the event of discrepancy between these terms and conditions and the Competition Notice, the Competition Notice shall prevail.
- The Darwin Waterfront Corporation reserves the right to cancel or amend the Competition or the Rules without notice in the event of any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside the Corporation's reasonable control. Any changes will be posted either within these terms and conditions or the Competition Notice. - The competition period is from 7am 1 December to 10pm Sunday 16 December 2018.
- All decisions, including winning entrants, prizes issued are final.
- Darwin Waterfront Corporation employees and contractors, and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter.
- Darwin Waterfront Retail employees, agents and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter.
- Winning entrants must be available to collect their prize at the Darwin Waterfront on Sunday 23 December 2018.
- All entrants must have the permission of their parent or legal guardian to participate in the competition and by entering, consent is given for public promotion and communication of the winning entrants details including, but not limited to, names, ages, suburb, photo and video. By participating, parents and legal guardians consent to the filming of the prize ceremony featuring the entrant and the unlimited use of that footage for marketing and publicity purposes at the discretion of the Darwin Waterfront Corporation.

Eligibility

- Entrants must be aged between 0 years and 15 years of age. Proof of age may be requested prior to a prize being awarded and failure to provide will disqualify the entry.
- All fields on the entry form must be completed correctly and must be legible.
- Proof of purchase receipts from retailers at the Darwin Waterfront (obtained during the competition period) to the minimum value of \$20 per entry, must be attached to each entry form.
- All wish list items listed by the entrant must be available locally for purchase in Darwin at the time of competition close and entrants agree to substitution for a similar product should retail availability change. Where wish list items (or substitute) are not available in the Darwin retail market, the entry will be disqualified.
- There is no limit as to how many entries can be provided per person, but all entries must meet eligibility criteria.
- Winning entrants must be available to collect their prize at the Darwin Waterfront on Sunday 23 December 2018.

How to enter

- Spend a minimum of \$20 (including GST) or more at any retailer at the Darwin Waterfront to receive one entry form.
- One entry form will be provided per transaction with corresponding receipt of purchase.
- Complete the entry form and attach proof of purchase receipt to entry.
- Submit entry form via Santa's Letter Box located at the Ground Floor of the Glass Observation Lifts at Darwin Waterfront during the competition period.
- Entrants can list between 1 and 5 gift items they wish to receive. It is not compulsory to list 5 items. It is not necessary for the total to equal \$1,000 (including GST), however the total retail value cannot exceed \$1,000 (including GST).

Drawing of Prize/Prizes

- All entries submitted will be reviewed and assessed based on eligibility.
- All eligible entries will be divided into three categories and one winner ONLY will be drawn from each category.
 1. Ages 0-5 years
 2. Ages 6-10 years
 3. Ages 11-15 years
- Wish list prizes must be available for purchase at a retail store in Darwin, Northern Territory, Australia.
- Wish list prizes must be age appropriate.
- The Corporation does not provide any guarantee or assurance that the prizes as listed on the entry form will be exact to the requirements or meet expectations by the entrant.
- The total value of awarded wish list items/prizes per category will not exceed the retail value of \$1,000 (including GST) per category.
- There are no refunds or exchanges of prizes issued. The Darwin Waterfront Corporation provides no warranty for any of the products, however proof of purchase will be available to prize winners for individual warranty claims with product manufacturer/retailer.
- The Corporation may (at its discretion) exclude or substitute particular prizes nominated on the list, without notice, based on availability, value and suitability of the product.
- Any prizes that become faulty or damaged after being issued to the winning entrant, become the responsibility of the entrant to follow up with the retailer directly. The Corporation expressly excludes any responsibility or liability, however arising, related to the use, quality or performance of any wish list prize.
